

2007 SEASON IN REVIEW

The senior class of 2007 leads the team onto the field for the season finale against Louisiana College. One senior, Dwight Bonner (21), decided to come back for the 2008 season in order to use his final year of eligibility.

Sophomore Anthony Smith (Bay City/Bay City) was named the David Wehmeyer Most Valuable Offensive Player (non-lineman award), the Mike Washington Most Valuable Offensive Player and the Jim Wacker Most Valuable Player at the conclusion of the 2007 TLU Football season.

Smith rushed for a TLU NCAA Division III-era record 1,066 yards and scored a team-best 66 points. He scored six rushing TDs, four receiving TDs and had a 92-yard kickoff return for a touchdown on the opening kickoff of the 2007 season. Smith led the ASC in all purpose yards (a school-record 1,989) and finished fifth in NCAA Division III in all-purpose yards per game (198.9).

Senior linebacker Andy Puryear (El Campo/El Campo) received the D.W. Rutledge Most Valuable Defensive Player Award and the Tom Mueller Outstanding Linebacker Award. Puryear led the ASC in total tackles per game (10.6) and established a new TLU non-scholarship era record for total tackles in a season. Puryear collected 106 total tackles and led the team in tackles for loss, with 14. Puryear was named to the ASC All-Conference First Team for a second straight season. He finished his TLU career with the second-most tackles of the TLU non-scholarship era (1998-2007). Puryear amassed 279 tackles in 40 games.

Fellow senior linebacker Matt Alves was named the Max Ender Comeback Player of the Year and the Matt Alves Academic Excellence Award Winner. Alves is the only ESPN The Magazine Academic All-American for football in school history. He has been named to the Academic All-America Team two times, in 2006-07 and in 2007-08. Alves was a First Team Academic All-America selection in 2007-08 and

was a Second Team Academic All-America selection in 2006-07.

Alves is the third student-athlete in TLU history to achieve First Team Academic All-America status. Women's basketball player Chantel Mize and men's basketball player Tommy Stolhandske are the two other First Team Academic All-America honorees in TLU history.

In Alves' four-year football career with TLU, he collected 112 total tackles and had 19.0 tackles for loss. Alves was fourth on the team in total tackles in 2007 with 60. He also had 8.5 tackles for loss, 2.5 sacks, two recovered fumbles and a blocked kick.

The 2007 Capt. Thomas E. Eddy Memorial Award was given to defensive lineman/offensive lineman Eric Walker (Los Fresnos/Los Fresnos). Walker, a junior entering the 2008 season, played in all 10 games in 2007. He recorded 14 total tackles and had two tackles for loss. The Eddy Award celebrates the life of Capt. Thomas E. Eddy Award, a New Braunfels native and former Texas Lutheran offensive guard and linebacker. Capt. Eddy was killed in action in Vietnam on June 26, 1966. Family and friends established the Capt. Thomas E. Eddy Memorial Award, which is given each year to an outstanding TLU football player (usually an offensive or defensive linemen or a linebacker) who best exemplifies the spirit and determination of Capt. Eddy.

Other year-end football awards went to: senior Casey Wedding (San Antonio/Smithson Valley), Outstanding Defensive Lineman Award; Dwight Bonner (Katy/Katy), Carl Schoessow Outstanding Defensive Back Award; Josh McNeil (Killeen/Killeen), Bill Lehman Outstanding Offensive Lineman Award; and Frank Vera

(Laredo/Nixon), Special Teams Most Valuable Player.

Wedding, a First Team All-ASC selection, led all ASC defensive linemen in total tackles, with 68. Wedding also had 10.5 tackles for loss for 51 yards with a team-leading 3.5 sacks for 24 yards. Wedding also broke up two passes and forced three fumbles.

Bonner, also a First Team All-ASC choice, was second on the team in tackles, with 69, and second in the conference for tackles among defensive backs. Bonner had 5.5 tackles for loss for nine yards. He also intercepted three passes for 56 yards and had eight pass break-ups. Bonner scored on a blocked punt in the three-overtime road loss to Sul Ross State. Bonner's three interceptions brought his career total to 12.

McNeil, a three-year starter at center, started all 10 games for TLU. He led an offensive unit that produced 154.4 yards rushing per game. The Bulldogs scored an average of 24 points per contest.

Vera, the team's punter and holder, also displayed his passing skills in the 2007 season. Vera tossed two passes all year, and both passes went for touchdowns against Sul Ross State in Alpine, Texas. Vera tossed a half-back option pass to Anthony Smith for a touchdown in regulation, and Vera completed a touchdown pass to Jerry Clouse on a fake field goal attempt in overtime. Vera also had the occasional rushing attempt because of a bad snap and rushed six times for 47 yards, with a long run of 27. He also punted 56 times for a 36.6 average, with a long of 62.

Two awards – a coaching award and a booster award – were also given at the banquet. The Jiggs Westergard Outstanding Assistant Coach Award was given to Joe Matulich and John Jennings, and the Kermit Westerholm Most Spirited Booster Award was given to Mark Westerholm.

The year brought to a close a fine four-year career for kicker Holt Storrie. The San Antonio Clark product, a two-time All-American, received ASC All-Conference First Team honors for the third time in his career. Storrie also was named to the All-Conference First Team in 2004 and 2005. Storrie was 8-for-15 on field goal attempts and 26-for-27 on point-after attempts in his senior season. Storrie had a career-long field goal of 51 yards in the home victory over Howard Payne on Oct. 6.

For his career, Storrie made a school-record 35 field goals on 48 attempts and had a school-record 118 successful point-after attempts. His career point total of 223 ranks second on the TLU all-time scoring list, behind NAIA and TLU Hall of Famer Mike Washington's 246 points.

TLU finished 2007 with a 2-8 overall record and a 2-6 conference mark. The Bulldogs placed seventh in the final standings of the nine-team ASC. The 2007 season was the first year for Dennis Parker as TLU's head coach. ■
