### Game Overview

Saturday's game between Texas Lutheran and Howard Payne will be the 35<sup>th</sup> all-time meeting between the two longtime football rivals. Howard Payne leads the series by a count of 20-13-1, but TLU has won three of the last four, including the last two at Gordon Wood Stadium in Brownwood, Texas.

Last year's 55-48 win for Texas Lutheran over Howard Payne came down to the team that had the ball last. In the 2007 Homecoming game for TLU, the Bulldogs posted the win on a TD pass from Bryant Villa to Jerry Clouse with 20 seconds to play in regulation. Last year's game featured 103 total points, 52 first downs, 853 yards passing, and 1,088 yards of total offense.

Howard Payne will try to return the favor in posting a Homecoming win over Texas Lutheran. It will be HPU Homecoming 2008 in Brownwood on Saturday.

This year's match-up may not have quite the firepower of last season's shootout. Both teams come into the game with struggling offenses. The Bulldogs rank seventh out of the nine ASC teams in scoring offense with a production of 13.8 points per game. After scoring 34 points in an overtime win over Sul Ross State in week one, the Bulldogs scored 21 points in the last three games. Granted, TLU has faced then No. 3 Mary Hardin-Baylor and then No. 22 Trinity in weeks two and three, respectively.

Howard Payne enters Saturday's game with the worst scoring offense in the ASC. The Yellow Jackets have scored just 26 points in their first three games, an average scoring output of 8.7 points per game. (continued in next column)

The Yellow Jackets were shutout 17-0 in Alpine last Saturday by Sul Ross State. TLU and HPU rank seventh and ninth, respectively, in total offense. TLU averages 282.2 yards of total offense. HPU averages 228 per game.

HPU is up to third in the league in total defense, holding opponents to 268.0 yards per game. The Bulldog defense is last, allowing 415.5 yards per game.

Now, statistics can be misleading. While TLU has played two Top 25 teams and an East Texas Baptist squad now 2-0 in the ASC, the Yellow Jackets have started 2008 with games against Texas College (NAIA), Bacone College (NAIA) and conference foe Sul Ross State. TLU downed Sul Ross State 34-27 in OT in Alpine on Sept. 6. HPU failed to score a point and committed seven turnovers in its trek to Alpine.

Both teams have suffered shutouts in 2008. TLU was shut-out 24-0 in its loss in San Antonio to Trinity. The shutout suffered by Howard Payne against Sul Ross State last weekend was the Yellow Jackets first game without scoring a point since Oct. 18, 2003.

TLU Head Coach Dennis Parker will look for his second straight win over Howard Payne. The 55-48 win for TLU over HPU gave Parker his first victory as the Bulldogs' head coach.

HPU Head Coach Steve Fanara started his coaching time at HPU with a 20-13 home victory over Texas College. HPU's two losses have come on the road.

TLU has won one game on the road in the Dennis Parker era. That win came this season in the 2008 opener at Sul Ross State. TLU is 1-7 on the road in Parker's first eight away games with the Bulldogs.

## When Texas Lutheran has the ball ...

### Bulldog Offense

Texas Lutheran's offense relies on the many talents of its junior running back Anthony Smith and the versatility of its senior quarterback Joel Waldon. The Bulldogs will try for Waldon to get the ball to Smith in a variety of ways – whether by hand-off or pass reception.

Last week, Smith lined up as a receiver on several occasions and carried the ball a season-low 14 times. He did manage 57 yards rushing, but 45 of those yards came on one play – a 45-yard scoring run in the first quarter. Smith caught only two passes, both on little shuttle passes, and he lost a combined one yard on the two grabs.

Smith's carry totals have dropped in four consecutive games. He carried the ball 22 times and rushed for 123 yards with a TD in the season-opening win over Sul Ross State. He followed the 22 carries with 16 carries for 45 yards against Trinity. Against Mary Hardin-Baylor, Smith's 15 carries netted 81 yards. Last week against ETBU, Smith rushed 14 times for 57 yards with the 45-yard TD run.

Smith currently ranks fifth in the ASC in rushing yards per game, with 76.5. He has 306 yards rushing and averages 4.6 yards per carry.

Waldon has started all four games at quarterback for the Bulldogs. Saturday's game will mark his seventh game as TLU's starting quarterback. Waldon is 2-4 as a starter for the Bulldogs.

Waldon has started the season by completing 54.2 percent of his passes. He has completed 58-of-107 for 575 yards. He has thrown three touchdown passes and two interceptions. He is fifth in the ASC in passing per game (143.8) and in passing efficiency (104.9).

Waldon is also an effective runner when needed. His 33 rushes have gained 115 yards and lost 70 (most the results of sacks), and he has a long run of 20 yards and a touchdown.

Waldon's top receiving targets are senior Kash Greathouse and junior Steven Thrash. Greathouse is the Bulldogs' top possession receiver. He has a team-best 22 grabs for 252 yards, but he has yet to score a touchdown. Greathouse's long grab of the season went for 30 yards.

Thrash brings more big-play ability. He has scored on a 52-yard pass play from Waldon and had a stretch of three games in which he had at least one reception of more than 38 yards. He had a long of 42 against Sul Ross State, a 38-yarder against Trinity, and the 52-yarder against UMHB. Thrash's streak of 38-yard-plus plays came to an end against ETBU last week, when Thrash was held to three catches for 14 yards, but he did score on a 1-yard toss from Waldon.

The offensive line has surrendered 10 sacks so far in 2008, and five of those sacks came last week in the loss to East Texas Baptist. The five sacks led to 35 yards in losses and effectively killed TLU's last two drives into ETBU territory. Waldon took several hard shots and received treatment from the TLU athletic trainers on the sideline during the game. (Waldon did not miss a snap.)

The Bulldogs do use tight end Ty Palmer and fullback Kyle Gillis to help with the blocking. Gillis, a former All-ASC Second Team selection on the offensive line, also has caught four passes for 19 yards and a touchdown.

### Yellow Jacket Defense

The Yellow Jackets bring impressive defensive statistics into Saturday's game with the Bulldogs. They have the second-ranked scoring defense in the league and the third-ranked team in total defense. Howard Payne allows just 14.3 points per game and 268.0 yards of total offense per game.

The rushing defense holds opponents to 110.0 rushing yards per game and to just three yards per carry.

The pass defense is fourth in the ASC in yards allowed per game (158.0). The Yellow Jackets have allowed only two TD passes in 2008. They have picked off three passes and held opponents to a 49.4 completion percentage.

Howard Payne has sacked opposing quarterbacks six times in three games for 44 yards in losses.

Opposing teams are converting just 21.4 percent of third downs against the HPU defense. The third-down stat for HPU leads the American Southwest Conference.

Linebacker Kevin Reyna, a junior transfer from Washington State, is Howard Payne's leading tackler. Reyna has collected 24 total tackles in three games, an average of eight per game. He ranks ninth in the ASC in tackles per game.

Sophomore defensive tackle Dustin McClure is second on the team in total tackles, with 19. Cornerback Conner Julian and safety Eric Bunch lead the secondary in tackles. Each player has a total of 16.

McClure is in the top five in the conference for sacks. He has 2.5 total sacks – two solo sacks and a tackle assist. Other team sacks have gone to Reyna (1.5 for 7 yards), and defensive tackle Chase Reneau (1 for 8) and defensive end Allen Dixon (1 for 15).

Reneau leads the team in tackles for loss, with four for 13. Dixon has the most yards for loss, with four tackles for 21 yards in losses.

The three interceptions for the Yellow Jackets have gone to Bunch (1 for 37), Reneau (1 for -3), and cornerback Aaron Alvarado (1 for -2).

Howard Payne has recovered three fumbles and forced three fumbles. They have also blocked two kicks – one by McClure and one by Bunch.

## When Texas Lutheran has the ball ...

### Yellow Jacket Offense

Howard Payne's offense has scored four touchdowns in three games – three via the pass and one via the run. Sophomore quarterback Zach Hubbard has started all three games and has all the passing stats for the Yellow Jackets. Hubbard is completing 49.5 percent of his passes, and he has thrown six interceptions. Three of the picks came in last week's loss to Sul Ross State.

Hubbard has thrown for 437 yards on 48 completions. He averages 145.7 yards of passing per game. Hubbard's favorite target is Cody Hambrick, who has caught 13 passes for 108 yards and a touchdown. Hambrick has a long reception of 30 yards and averages 36 yards receiving per game.

Junior running back Cody McKenzie leads the Yellow Jackets in rushing with 42 carries for 171 yards, an average of 4.1 yards per carry. He has a TD run and a long run of 20.

The Yellow Jackets rank last in the conference in scoring offense and total offense. HPU is eighth out of nine teams in both passing and rushing.

HPU has scored two TDs in seven trips into the red zone. Four of the trips inside the red zone have ended in interception or downs.

HPU is seventh in the league in turnover margin, at -1.33. Howard Payne has forced seven turnovers but turned the ball over 11 times (five fumbles and six interceptions).

Howard Payne has been hurt by penalties. The Yellow Jackets have committed 30 penalties for 253 yards, an average of 84.3 yards per game.

### **Bulldog Defense**

TLU's defense has been hit hard in its first four games. The Bulldogs are eighth in the nine-team league in scoring defense (35.0 points per game) and last in the league in total defense (415.5 yards allowed per game). The rushing defense is giving up 259.8 yards per game (last in the league). Opponents have rushed 178 times for 1,039 yards. Opposing ball carriers are averaging 5.8 yards per carry. TLU has allowed 13 rushing TDs.

The pass defense for TLU is third in the league. But with opposing running backs producing against the Bulldogs, teams have taken the yards on the ground and foregone the risk of the pass. TLU has had only 79 passes thrown against it in four games. That average of 19.75 passes against per game is the lowest in the league. TLU has allowed six TD passes over the first four games, and opposing quarterbacks are completing 50.6 percent of their passes against the Bulldogs.

The Bulldogs have allowed the most first downs per game, 21.8, in the conference, and TLU opponents convert 43.8 percent of third-down attempts.

TLU has forced four turnovers in four games – three recovered fumbles and one interception.

Individually, the Bulldogs are led in tackles by safety Dwight Bonner and linebacker Jarrad McAdams. Bonner, a senior, has 37 total tackles, a half-tackle for loss and the team's lone interception. He has also broken up three passes (tied for the team lead with Robert Bonner). McAdams, a sophomore, is second on the team with 35 total tackles. He comes off a game in which he led all players in tackles with 13. McAdams also forced a fumble and blocked a field goal against East Texas Baptist. For the year, McAdams has 1.5 tackles for loss, a fumble recovery, a forced fumble and a blocked kick.

First-year safety Rolton Stevens has started all four games of his collegiate career. He is third on the team in tackles, with 27. He has a tackle for loss, a sack, a pass break-up and a quarterback hurry.

James Villarreal, the senior defensive end, leads the squad in tackles for loss (5-for-24). Villarreal has two sacks, a quarterback hurry and two forced fumbles.

Villarreal shares the sack lead with junior defensive end John Jackson, who recorded nine tackles, two tackles for loss and a sack against Mary Hardin-Baylor.

### **Bulldog Special Teams**

The Bulldogs have struggled on special teams for the most part in 2008. TLU has yet to convert a field goal (0-for-4), the unit has given up a 100-yard kickoff return for a touchdown.

Josh Spaw will handle the kickoff duties and field goal kicking, and Frank Vera will start at punter. Freshman Zach Rowland has been a pleasant surprise in the return game. Rowland averages 18.9 yards per kick return and has a long of 30.

### **Yellow Jacket Special Teams**

Kick returner Jared Shaw averages 27 yards per return and has a long of 45. Punter Cote Schacherl averages 36.0 yards per punt and has a long of 50. Place kicker Nathan Gilbert is 2-for-4 on PATs. He has not attempted a field goal

On Jan. 22, 2007, Dennis Parker returned to his Texas coaching roots as the new head football coach at Texas Lutheran University. Parker was named TLU's 19th football coach. Coach Parker coached the Bulldogs to a 2-8 season in 2007 with a 2-6 mark in the American Southwest Conference.

Parker's overall collegiate coaching mark currently stands at 14-32-1 counting his three full seasons at North Texas (11-21-1) and his 14 games at TLU (3-11).

Parker coached Mesa High School in Mesa, Ariz., for the three seasons prior to coming to TLU. Parker coached Mesa to a 3-7 record in 2004, a 5-5 mark in 2005 and a 7-4 record in 2006. Parker guided the Jackrabbits to the state playoffs in 2006. For Mesa, the playoff appearance was its first since 2000.

Parker has collegiate coaching experience as the head coach of NCAA Division I University of North Texas. He coached at North Texas for the 1991, 1992 and 1993 seasons. Parker was also an assistant coach at Southeast Missouri State University from 1977 to 1981.

Steve Fanara took over as head coach of the Howard Payne Yellow Jackets after serving the previous three seasons as the defensive coordinator at HPU. Fanara first coached the HPU defense in 2005 and improved the Yellow Jackets significantly in several conference categories, including total defense, rushing defense, scoring defense and pass efficiency defense. The Yellow Jackets finished second in the ASC in rushing defense, improving 205 yards per game in 2004 to allowing just 110 yards per game in 2005. Fanara's defense also set an American Southwest Conference record for interceptions in a season, with 29 in 10 games in 2005.

Fanara, now in his 22<sup>nd</sup> year of coaching, has also spent time at the collegiate level with MidAmerica Nazarene, Olivet Nazarene, Southwest Baptist, and the United States Military Academy Prep School. He has served as the recruiting coordinator at two schools and has held both offensive and defensive coordinator titles. While serving under Bobby Ross at the Army's Prep School, Fanara coached safety Caleb Campbell, a 2008 NFL draft pick of the Detroit Lions.

## **Last Time Out for TLU: ETBU rolls out powerful rushing attack in 24-16 win**

The East Texas Baptist rushing tandem of Corey George and Jair Stover combined to rush for 247 yards and three touchdowns in the Tigers' 24-16 win over Texas Lutheran at Seguin's Matador Stadium on Saturday evening.

The Tigers (2-1, 2-0 American Southwest Conference) ran the ball 43 times for 227 yards, averaging 5.3 yards per carry, and tallied 385 yards of total offense to TLU's 188.

Despite being rolled over by the ETBU running game, TLU (1-3, 0-2 ASC) still crept within five points at 19-14 and had a 1st-and-10 from the ETBU 42 early in the fourth quarter. That Bulldog drive ended with a Frank Vera punt after the Bulldogs lost 10 yards on the next three plays thanks to a tackle for a loss and two sacks.

Still trailing by five later in the fourth, TLU hit midfield with a first down on a Joel Waldon run of 20 yards. But again the ETBU defense denied the Bulldogs. Another tackle for loss and then two more sacks sandwiched around an incomplete pass turned the ball back to the Tigers on downs.

ETBU gained the ball on the TLU 32 and promptly marched into the TLU endzone after just four plays to put the game out of reach. On the game-clinching drive, George rushed three times for 31 yards. ETBU quarterback Stephen Oehlschlaeger capped the scoring march with a 1-yard plunge.

George carried the ball 17 times for 132 yards, and Stover rushed 21 times for 115. George had TD runs of three and two yards, and Stover hit paydirt on a carry of 29 yards.

After falling behind 7-0 on Anthony Smith's 45-yard scoring run in the first quarter, ETBU put 13 points on the board in the second quarter. The Tigers lead could have been more in the first half but the Tigers missed a 28-yard field goal and had a bad snap on another field goal try. A third field goal attempt in the first half turned into a fake field goal that failed to produce a yard.

TLU linebacker Jarrad McAdams led all players in tackles with 13. McAdams also forced a fumble and blocked a field goal. Bulldog defensive end James Villarreal recorded three tackles, two tackles for loss, a sack, a forced fumble, and a quarterback hurry. Linebacker Jack Moses registered three tackles, 1.5 tackles for loss, a fumble recovery, and a sack for 14 yards.

## **Last Time Out for HPU: Yellow Jackets shut-out in Alpine 17-0**

Howard Payne Yellow Jackets turnovers lead to a 17-0 loss to Sul Ross State University in American Southwest Conference action at Jackson Field.

After a Howard Payne fumble on their 8-yard line, Sul Ross State scored on a 4-yard run by Nelson Veliz. The score for SRSU produced a 7-0 lead with 13:27 to play in the first quarter.

Sul Ross added a 19-yard field goal with two seconds to play in the first half, capping a 6 play 45-yard drive.

Turnovers were the big issue for both teams in the game with Sul Ross State having an interception and two fumbles lost. Howard Payne lost four fumbles and tossed three interceptions.

Neither team scored again till the 3:09 mark of the 4th quarter when Monte Morales scored for Sul Ross on a 1-yard run.

Cody McKenzie lead Howard Payne with 66 yards on 12 carries, while Zach Hubbard was 13 of 31 passing for 97 yards and 3 INT.

Lorenzo Green led the HPU defense with 10 tackles. He was followed by Chase Reneau and Dustin McClure with 9 tackles each.

Sul Ross running back Jermaine Swearington rushed for 177 yards on 24 carries. Moreles was 13 of 25 passing for 133 yards and 1 INT.

The shutout was the first for Howard Payne since Mary Hardin-Baylor shut down the Yellow Jackets 31-0 on Oct. 18, 2003.

## **Last Meeting between TLU - HPU Oct. 6, 2007, in Seguin, Texas (TLU 55, HPU 48)**

SEGUIN, Texas – The Texas Lutheran Bulldogs gave Dennis Parker his first win as TLU's head coach and thrilled a Homecoming crowd with a wild 55-48 victory over Howard Payne, Saturday afternoon at Seguin's Matador Stadium.

Texas Lutheran improved to 1-5 overall and to 1-3 in the American Southwest Conference. Howard Payne fell to 0-5 and to 0-3 in the ASC. HPU has lost its last four games by a combined 18 points.

Back-up QB Bryant Villa (San Antonio/McCollum) hit senior wide receiver Jerry Clouse (San Antonio/Madison) for a 27-yard TD with 20 seconds to play in the game. The scoring drive, which covered five plays and 71 yards in 1:15, was kept alive by a roughing the kicker penalty at the TLU 33.

Villa took advantage of the roughing the kicker penalty to hit Steven Trash for 27 yards and then connect with Clouse for the game-winner. Clouse had four catches for 53 yards, and Trash caught a career-best four for 88 yards.

Villa entered the game in the first quarter for an injured Andrew Stewart and threw for a career-best 287 yards with four touchdowns. Villa's TD passes went to Anthony Smith, Jonathon Randle, Kash Greathouse and Clouse.

All of Villa's TD passes came in the second half, starting with a 4-yard scoring strike to Smith at the 5:44 mark of the third quarter. Villa was 22-for-45 through the air and was hurt by several dropped pass from his receivers. Villa did not throw an interception.

The game featured 1,088 yards of total offense, a TLU option pass from running back Travis Dyson to Keith Kaiser for a 13-yard TD, and a 75-yard punt return for a TD by Jesse Gremminger, who also returned a punt for a TD against HPU last season.

HPU amassed 553 yards of total offense on just 59 plays. TLU took 99 plays to produce 535 yards. The Bulldogs held the ball for a whopping 36:27.

Anthony Smith rushed 23 times for TLU and had 98 yards. Smith had a 4-yard TD reception and four total catches for 30 yards. Smith also returned six kicks for 116 yards with a long of 28.
