Remote Access to Online Databases

1. Remote access is available to TLU faculty, staff, affiliates and currently enrolled students.
2. On the Library Home Page, click the link entitled DATABASES BY TITLE.
3. When you click one of the databases, such as “eLibrary Curriculum,” you will be prompted to log in with your LAST name (only) and TLU ID number. Do not share your login information.

K-12 (Kindergarten – High School) Resources

1. Navigate to the Library Home Page at <<http://www.tlu.edu/library>>
2. Click DATABASES BY SUBJECT
3. Click K-12



To search for a children's book

1. Navigate to the Library Home Page at <<http://www.tlu.edu/library>>
2. Click "Search the TLU Library Catalog"
3. Click the ADVANCED search tab
4. In the LOCATION box, choose "Children's Literature"
5. In the SEARCH box, type an author's last name or part of a title, if you have a specific book in mind (see the example below):

7. Use the location information that appears for the book. Go to the 2nd floor to retrieve the book. Then, take it to the Circulation Desk for checkout. The checkout period is one week for children's books.
