SPRING 2010 REGISTRATION INSTRUCTIONS FOR CURRENTLY ENROLLED STUDENTS

STUDENTS WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO REGISTER FOR CLASSES UNLESS THEY HAVE MET WITH THEIR ADVISOR. IF THERE ARE ANY HOLDS LISTED IN YOUR MY.TLU.EDU STUDENT ACCOUNT, YOU MUST CLEAR THESE PRIOR TO REGISTRATION.

Step I - Course Selection

- 1) Go to My.TLU.edu and sign in to your student account. Click on the *Student* tab, and select *Registration and Advising*. You will find information there on registering for courses.
- 2) See your academic advisor and get clearance for online registration.
- 3) Check the Registration Holds portion of the *Registration and Advising* page in your My.TLU.edu account. If you have holds, you must get them cleared with the appropriate office before you can register.
- 4) Students have a designated registration time based on the number of hours they have earned. Your online registration time is displayed for you in your My.TLU.edu student account, on the *Registration and Advising* page, in the *Registration Times Info* section. Have a question about your registration time? Call the Office of Registration & Records at 830-327-8040.
- 5) Make-up registration and schedule changes may be made December 3-4.

Step II - Payment of Fees

A bill will be mailed to the student's permanent home address in December. Students may choose to pay in full or submit the first installment of the monthly payment plan by January 4, 2010. **IF PAYMENT OR PAYMENT ARRANGEMENTS ARE NOT MADE BY JANUARY 4, HOUSING RESERVATIONS AND CLASS SCHEDULES MAY BE DELETED!** A \$50 late fee will be assessed to all students who do not return requested billing materials and meet the initial payment deadline.

Step III - Required Check-in

Students who have completed Steps I and II must check-in and pick up their official schedule on **Sunday, January 10, 2010, between 1-4 p.m.** Students who do not check-in and confirm their registration on January 10 will have their schedule deleted.

Step IV – Schedule Changes

Students who wish to add or drop a course may make schedule changes at My.TLU.edu, or in the Office of Registration & Records, beginning Monday, January 11th, 2010. There is no charge for schedule changes made on January 11th or 12th. Students must have their advisor's approval in order to add or drop a course. There is a \$3 fee per change after January 12.

LATE REGISTRATION

Late registration takes place in the Office of Registration & Records (BC 101) on January 11-15, 2010, from 8:30 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. A late registration fee of \$100 is assessed for all late registrations. **The last day to register for the Spring 2010 semester is Friday, January 15.**

REGISTRATION INFO

New students will receive registration instructions during orientation in early January. Returning students should visit their My.TLU.edu account, print off a copy of a registration card and a transcript, and see their advisor for registration clearance.

ADVISING

Students meet with their academic advisor to discuss course selection and receive registration clearance.

REGISTRATION

Students may register between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. Returning students who have been cleared by their advisor may register online using My.TLU.edu. New students will register in the Office of Registration & Records after seeing an advisor.

PAYMENT

Payment in full, or the 1st installment (40%) if using the payment plan, will be due at the time of registration. Refer to the TLU catalog for information regarding tuition, fees, and refund policies.

FAMILY EDUCATIONAL RIGHTS AND PRIVACY ACT (FERPA)

Texas Lutheran University makes every effort to comply with the Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act of 1974. This act is designed to protect the privacy of a student's educational records and the right of a student to his/her records. The Student Handbook and the TLU Bulletin both describe the policies that govern maintenance of and access to a student's personal and academic records. The policy permits disclosure of educational records under certain limited circumstances and routine disclosures, at the University's discretion of information defined by the University as directory information. Texas Lutheran defines directory information as the following: name, local , permanent and email address, phone number, major, minor, photo, participation in sports, height and weight of athletes, degree candidacy, degrees and awards received, number of registered hours, classification, academic honors, dates of attendance, and previous colleges attended. You have the right to prevent the disclosure of directory information by filing a request in writing in the Office of Registration and Records on the Request to Prevent Disclosure of Directory Information form (which is available in the Registrar's office). Such a request is good for one semester only.

Service Learning (SL) Courses

In academic service-learning, community service is integrated with academic (course) objectives to benefit both the community and the student. Students are graded on the quality of their service reflections and how well they connect their service experience(s) with course lectures, readings and other assignments. For more information about service-learning at TLU, please contact Tim Barr, Director of the Center for Servant Leadership, at 372-8162.

BUSI476: Corporate Tax

Students are not required to participate in the VITA (Volunteer Income Tax Assistance) program but will receive course benefits if they do. The project is directly tied to the learning outcomes of the course because students get hands-on experience preparing tax returns for actual clients in New Braunfels and Seguin, applying in the real world the theories they learned in class.

COMM335: Advanced Journalism

The service is creation of podcasts using interviews with local Latino leaders recorded by Dr. Gonzalez's Spanish students this semester. Students in the course will edit the interview material to present to a general audience. The course focuses students' attention on telling news stories in a multimedia context. Some of the interviews may be in Spanish, giving interested students the opportunity to work in Spanish (no one will be required to work in Spanish).

COMM374: Professional Speaking

In this course students will design and implement a workshop meeting community needs. As a part of this project, students will need to conduct an audience analysis, which will require them to get to know the people with whom they will be working.

COMM376E: Community Ethics

Students will identify a community issue, use social justice frameworks as a way to explore the issue and the social problems involved, and work within the community to identify and pursue a project which will work toward improving the social situation. Upon completion, students will reflect upon the lessons they learned through pursuing their project.

COMM479: Documentary Photography

The service is a field assignment to take photographs of the local Latino leaders who are participating in the project that Dr. Gonzalez initiated. The course explores the history and techniques of social documentary photography; all photo assignments will involve fieldwork. Fieldwork would be done by agreement between the student and the subject. Students will need photographic equipment for all assignments in this course.

HIST271: The African-American Experience

Students will choose from a variety of local service options, both deepening their understanding of African-American experiences in Seguin and also providing a specific, local context to associate with some of the historical eras covered in the course. All students will be expected to participate in at least one Saturday service project lasting 3-4 hours.

KINS232: Adapted Physical Education

Students will lead fitness and adapted physical education for disabled adults from Mosaic of South Central Texas. As a result of this course, students should be able to write lesson plans, conduct learning and fitness activities to groups and individuals, and be able to work with populations of varied age and ability. The service component of this class is mandatory and will happen during class time.

KINS377: Early Childhood Motor Programming

Students will work as individual physical educators for preschoolers at Faith Lutheran Preschool in Seguin. As a result of this course, students should be able to write lesson plans, conduct learning and fitness activities to groups and individuals, and be able to work with populations of varied age and ability.

PSYC379: Community Psychology Students are assigned to pairs and sent to various agencies, where they are required to spend 10-15 hours over a period of 6 weeks or so examining a public program (in educational, preventative, or treatment/intervention settings) and talking to the professional psychology/counseling staff. Every student must pass a background check.

SPAN376: Advanced Practice in Reading and Writing

Students will interview one Spanish-speaking Seguin resident in order to learn about local Mexican-American history. This experience will advance the student's ability to process information and write coherently in Spanish. The service project will require approximately 3-4 hours of time outside of the classroom, including an initial gathering to make introductions and a community celebration at the end of the semester.

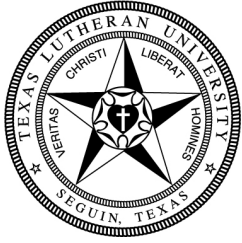
