Additional Information Related to Degree Plan

- (¹) FE134 requirement is waived for transfer students with 48 or more hours or transfer students with 9 hours from the following: introductory courses in philosophy/psychology/sociology; art or music appreciation; history; or literature.
- (²) Additional requirements include 1 writing intensive course (upper division), 1 ethics-focused course, and a senior capstone course, which are included in the business curriculum.
- (³) Natural Sciences Dimension requires 6 hours from Biology, Environmental, Chemistry or Physics with at least 1 of the courses including a lab.
- (⁴) Humanities Dimension requires 6 hours from Classical Studies, Geography, History, Literature (including modern language literature) or Philosophy with a maximum of 3 hours in any one discipline.
- (⁵) Social Sciences Dimension requires 6 hours from Economics, Political Science, Psychology or Sociology with a maximum of 3 hours in any one discipline.
- (⁶) Cross-Cultural Dimension requires 3 hours modern language or 3 years high school language or one semester study abroad. Requirement is waived for international students.
- (⁷) Personal Well Being Dimension requires 3 hours from ID211, 212, KIN121, PSY120, Kinesiology activity courses. At least 1 hour of activity courses must be taken and at least 1 hour from ID211, 212, KIN121, or PSY120.
- (⁸) The Arts Dimension requires 6 hours from Art, Dramatic Media or Music.
- (⁹) The Theological Dimension requires 6 hours from Theology.

Students may use one-interdisciplinary course of 3 credit hours (ex., ID131) to fulfill up to 3 hours of one of the dimension requirements. Such ID courses have their dimensions option specified in the course schedule.

Note: CR designates that Dimensions and/or Foundations requirements are waived by requirements in the core curriculum, specialization, and/or supporting courses area.
