Meningitis Vaccination Notification

In addition to completing the application for readmission, the on-campus housing application (if you need it), and registering for classes, there is an additional step you must complete in order to return to TLU. Texas state law requires all students attending an institution of higher education to be immunized against bacterial meningitis. According to the law, all students must be immunized or receive a booster shot during the five-year period preceding their enrollment and at least 10 days prior to the start of the term.

Evidence of vaccination can include any of the following:

- The signature or stamp of a physician or his/her designee, or public health personnel on a form which shows the month, day, and year the vaccination dose or booster was administered; or
- An official immunization record generated from a state or local health authority; or
- An official record received from school officials, including a record from another state

You are exempt from the new law if:

- You are 22 years of age or older; or
- Your physician signs an affidavit which states that the vaccination would be injurious to your health or well-being; or
- You complete the Texas Department of State Health Services conscientious exemption form
