include the following.

1. Completion of a minimum of 70 undergraduate credit hours.
2. Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.00 across MSDA prerequisite courses (see below)
3. Attainment of a 'B' or better in STAT 374

Application for admission to the concurrent MSDA program is made to the Office of Admissions. Materials needed to complete the application include:

1. A signed copy of the application acknowledging the intent to apply to the MSDA program.
2. Official transcripts from all colleges and universities attended NOT listed on the TLU transcript.
3. Letter providing additional information to be considered by the admissions committee (optional).

Applicants who have completed at least three of the MSDA pre-requisite courses may be “conditionally accepted” at the discretion of the MSDA admissions committee. Such students may be allowed to take the remainder of the MSDA pre-requisite courses concurrently with some graduate core courses.

Direct Admission to MS-DA program

Applicants who already hold a bachelor’s degree from an accredited university (SACSCOC or the equivalent) may apply for admission to the MSDA degree program. The MSDA admissions committee will consider strong academic performance throughout the applicant’s undergraduate degree programs, as well as other application materials.

Direct application for admission to the MSDA degree program is made to the Office of Admissions. Materials to complete one’s application file include:

1. A signed copy of the application acknowledging the intent to apply to the MSDA program.
2. Official transcripts from all colleges and universities attended not listed on the TLU transcript.
3. GMAT or GRE scores taken within the last five years (may be waived for currently enrolled students with 30 or more semester credit hours at TLU).
4. Current résumé.
5. Two letters of reference from individuals not sitting on the admissions committee (may be waived for currently enrolled students at TLU).
6. Letter providing additional information to be considered by the
